## Safety for the Supervisor Certificate - SSC

This course is designed for individuals who are moving into their first leadership/supervisory position. Though they may not be a safety manager or director by title, they have a crucial role to play in ensuring safe work practices are adhered to and the success of safety programs overall. This course will emphasize leadership and management principles.

### TOPICS INCLUDED

- Supervisor's role & responsibilities with respect to safety
- Safety culture
- Injury reporting & basic incident investigation
- Coaching skills
- Basic regulatory requirements: HAZCOM, Lockout/Tagout, Emergency Action Plans, Personal Protective Equipment, and others

## Safety for the Human Resource Professional - SHRP

This certificate course is intended for HR professionals whether you are new to safety, responsible for safety, or working with the safety department. The topics and depth of coverage will help HR professionals recognize and understand the basics of safety regulations and other important safety considerations that apply to their organizations. By completing this certificate, attendees will be prepared to recognize areas of regulatory and financial safety risk, plus come away with a road map to address shortcomings in their current safety program.

### TOPICS INCLUDED

- Recordkeeping Basics (OSHA log requirements, relationship between log and workers compensation, etc.)
- Reduction of Risk (Workplace violence, ergonomics risk factors, drug and alcohol testing, emergency plans, workplace driving policy, safety committees, etc.)
- OSHA (Scope/purpose, chemical hazard communication, basics on lockout/tagout, fall protection, & confined space, PPE/loud noise, electrical safety, forklift operator requirements, first aid/bloodborne pathogens, etc.)
- Department of Transportation (DOT) Basic Requirements

## Certified Safety & Health Official - CSHO

This program focuses on the responsibilities of safety professionals and reviews extensively federal occupational safety and health standards. The program covers employer's responsibilities with regards to occupational safety and health. Additionally, the Certified Safety and Health Official certificate of completion covers OSHA policies and procedures. The CSHO certificate of completion provides two clear and defined study paths based on the participants area of interest. Program participants are required to select one of the two tracks available; Construction or General Industry Safety.

In addition to the CSHO, one course in risk management and two courses in environmental safety must be completed.
